










GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC RECYCLING & COMPOSTING

NOT ACCEPTED:

-  NO Styrofoam
-  NO Plastic Utensils
-  NO Plastic or Plastic-coated plates
-  NO Cups
-  NO Meat or dairy products

ACCEPTED:

-  Paper Plates
-  Chopsticks
-  Veggies, pasta & grain food scraps
-  Napkins

GUIDELINES FOR VENDOR RECYCLING & COMPOSTING

The vendor recycling site for glass, metal, plastic, drink boxes, paper and cardboard will be located against the west side of the dumpster.

DRINK BOXES (Milk/Soy-type box cartons): Please rinse and flatten.



GLASS: All colors accepted. Please rinse, discard plastic lids.

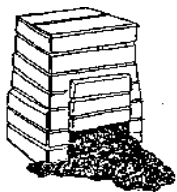


METALS: Please remove labels and recycle as low grade paper. Rinse and flatten. Metal lids go here!



PLASTIC BOTTLES/TUBS/JARS: Please rinse, flatten and discard plastic lids. NO plastic bags!

LOW GRADE PAPER: All varieties of paper. NO food-contaminated paper, paper cups, paper plates or corrugated cardboard please!



PRE-CONSUMER FOOD WASTE: Please place all food waste in bins marked "Food Waste Only". No meat, dairy or post-consumer food waste please. Labeled food waste collection containers will be distributed to the food vendors the morning of set-up.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Please flatten boxes and place in collection cages next to dumpsters.



RINSE STATION: A rinse station will be located in front of Straub Hall (south side of vendor area). This is the place to rinse out recyclables.
